Hypercom Battery Safety Tips

Hypercom's battery operated EFTPOS terminals include a rechargeable battery and a battery charger. The charger allows the terminal to place calls even when the terminal is charging. For optimal performance of the terminal and battery, avoid partial charging of the battery. Charging a battery that is fully charged or is nearly fully charge may shorten battery life. The battery indicator on the Hypercom terminal will show the charge condition of the battery.

- Notes: 1. Most batteries will need to be fully charged for 12-24 hours before their initial use.
2. Battery life depends on usage, signal strength, network and temperature.



Please observe the instructions/points below:

- Use only Hypercom original and replacement batteries and battery chargers. Hypercom warranties do not cover damage caused by use of non-Hypercom batteries or non-Hypercom chargers.
- New batteries or batteries stored for a long time may take a longer period of time to charge.
- Keep batteries at room temperature when charging.
- Keep batteries in storage uncharged and in a cool, dark and dry place, such as a refrigerator.
- Never expose batteries to temperatures less than -10°C (14°F) or greater than 50°C (122°F).
- It is normal for batteries to gradually wear down, requiring longer charging times. If this becomes noticeable, it is likely the battery may be approaching the end of its effective life.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire because of the risk of explosion.
- Contact your local recycling center for proper and safe battery disposal.

Important Safety Information

Batteries may cause property damage and/or bodily injury, such as burns, if an electrically conductive material (e.g., jewelry, keys, beaded chains, etc.) touch exposed battery terminals. The conductive material may complete an electrical short circuit and could become very hot. Therefore, exercise care in handling any charged battery and when placing it inside a pocket, purse or other such container that also contains metal objects.

Hypercom batteries may have the following symbols attached and are described below:

| Symbol | Description |
|---|---|
|  | The battery requires recycling in accordance with local laws. Contact your local regulatory authorities for more related information. |
|  | The battery should not be thrown into the trash. |
| Li-ion | The battery is a lithium-ion battery. |
